Parents Code of Conduct

Pure and simple – It's the job of the parent's to set a positive example. If not you – then who?

As part of the Code of Conduct, parents' responsibilities include:

Treating the game, all players, coaches, referees, and fans with respect.

Letting the coach be the coach. It's his/her job. If you have input for the coach – please address it with the coach before or after the game. During the game, it's the coach's job to coach, and your job to cheer.

Support your team without denigrating the other team.

Never yell at or touch the referee.

Helping the coach by making sure your son/daughter is at practices and games on time and properly equipped.

Discuss issues/problems/concerns with the coach, the Director of Coaching, or the Director of boys/girls.

Assisting with any fundraisers and volunteering when needed.

Inappropriate behavior by any player, parent or spectator will result in the following disciplinary action:

1st Offense – Warning by official, head coach, WCFC Board Member, or Head of League.

2nd Offense – Removal from game field area.

3rd Offense – One game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file.

4th Offense – Season Suspension.
