**PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT**

Playing on a competitive team is a privilege; and with that privilege, comes responsibility. You are representing the Washington County Futbol Club, your team, your coach, your parents, and most importantly, yourself.

As part of the Code of Conduct, players' responsibilities include:

Treating the game, **all** players, coaches, referees, and fans with respect.

Active and cooperative participation in all practices.

Winning with character and losing with dignity.

Notifying their coach, at least 24 hours in advance whenever possible, if they cannot make a practice or game.

Knowing the rules and abiding by the referee's decision.

Displaying appreciation for good performance, regardless of the team.

Display good sportsmanship. No negative cheers or taunting of other players or referees.

Players on competitive teams are making a commitment to the team. We also firmly believe that all club activities are secondary to academic requirements.

Unless arrangements are made with their coach in advance, players are expected to attend all practices and games, as specified by the coach.

All potential conflicts, especially school sanctioned events (whether WIAA sanctioned athletic events or otherwise), must be addressed with the coach.

Inappropriate behavior by any player, parent or spectator will result in the following disciplinary action:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Warning by official, head coach, WCFC Board Member or Head of League or Organization.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Removal from game field area.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – One game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file.

4<sup>th</sup> Offense – Season Suspension
